The pair with the best scratch stableford score over 36 holes on the Saturday will hold the **NCGU SCRATCH TROPHY** for one year

**Afternoon: Handicap Match Play - finals and losing semi-finalists play-offs**

All entries must be made online through Golf Genius, via the NCGU website. The system will ask entrants for their CDH numbers and will request payment.

**The number of entries may be limited at the discretion of the NCGU Board. If entries exceed the limit, pairs with the higher combined Handicap Indexes shall be eliminated by ballot.**

The decision of the NCGU Board in all matters relating to this Championship shall be final.

Pairs shall be advised of their starting tee-time no later than seven days in advance of this Championship and will be allocated a Playing Handicap based on 50% of their combined Course Handicaps on the day of the Championship.
